

## Municipal Election Information

The City of Hobbs will conduct a regular municipal election on **TUESDAY, MARCH 2, 2010**. The offices to be filled are:

City Commissioner, District 4, Four-Year Term  
City Commissioner, District 5, Four-Year Term  
City Commissioner, District 6, Four-Year Term  
Municipal Judge, At Large, Four-Year Term

Two Charter amendments will also be submitted to the voters for consideration.

Any registered qualified elector of the City of Hobbs may be a candidate for the office of City Commissioner or Municipal Judge. In addition to being a registered qualified elector, candidates for the office of City Commissioner must have resided within the appropriate Commission District for 180 days prior to filing of that elector's Declaration of Candidacy. Candidates for the office of Municipal Judge must have resided within the City of Hobbs for 180 days prior to filing candidacy and have graduated from high school or obtained a GED equivalent.

The only day to file for office is on **TUESDAY, JANUARY 5, 2010, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8:00 A.M. AND 5:00 P.M. IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK AT CITY HALL, 200 EAST BROADWAY.**
