Summary:

Pursuant to §3-8-53, N.M.S.A., 1978, the City Clerk and City Commission of the City of Hobbs certify the canvass of returns of the regular municipal election held in the City of Hobbs, New Mexico, on March 6, 2018, and certify the results of such election in respect to each voting division and in respect to the total number of voters who voted.

- ▶ **1,321** votes were cast by voters at the four consolidated voting centers on election day.
- ▶ **447** early votes were cast on paper ballots in the Early Precinct and counted by an ImageCast Precinct Vote Tabulator.
- ▶ **47** ballots were issued in the Absentee Precinct; **1** ballot was not returned by 7:00 p.m.; making a total of **46** ballots. (44 of those ballots were inserted into the tabulator by the Absentee Precinct Board. 2 ballots were hand tallied as they could not be read by the tabulator.)

The total number of votes recorded in the election was **1,814**.

The voter turnout percentage for this election was 10.87% with a total of 16,690 eligible voters in the City of Hobbs.

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE CERTIFICATE OF CANVASS
OF THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD
MARCH 6, 2018, IN THE CITY OF HOBBS, NEW MEXICO.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the laws of the State of New Mexico, the regular municipal election of the City of Hobbs, New Mexico, was duly and lawfully held on the 6th day of March, 2018; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 3-8-53, N.M.S.A., 1978, the City Clerk of the City of Hobbs, together with the City Commission, Hobbs, Lea County, New Mexico, being the governing body of the municipality, have canvassed the returns of said election and that the total votes cast and the results thereof are as follows:
