

RIDING THE BUS

Have the exact change or pass ready when boarding the bus. Bus operators do not make change.

Children age 5 and under must be accompanied by a paying adult or a responsible paying sibling. Any child 6 years of age or under must have a car seat.

Times listed on the map are departure times. Please be at the bus stop 5 minutes before departure time. To board, riders must be at the bus stop when the bus arrives. Be visible and stay in the safe zone, away from the curb. Let others exit before boarding. Pay your cash fare or use your pass and move quickly to a seat. Please keep your feet, packages and personal belongings out of the aisles. All passengers are to maintain control of their possessions while riding the bus.

Hobbs Express is not responsible for lost or stolen property. When traveling with an infant and baby stroller, the stroller should be folded before entering the bus and should remain folded for the duration of the trip.

Major streets and stops are announced. Watch or listen for your stop. Signal the operator about a block before your stop. Riders may flag the bus down anywhere along the route; however, you must be further than one and a half blocks from a designated stop and be standing on the appropriate side of the roadway to board the bus. The bus will not stop in a dangerous traffic area.

SAFETY

Never run after or next to a moving bus. Do not cross in front of or behind the bus. Always use the crosswalk and obey traffic signals. Riders shall not move around while the bus is in motion. Passengers must wear seat belts. All wheelchairs must be secured. No eating, drinking or smoking on vehicles. Place litter in the trash container located at the front of the bus. No fighting, throwing, pushing, rough behavior, shouting or vulgar language and gestures will be allowed. No playing loud music, games or cell phones. Keep feet off seats. No weapons of any kind are allowed on any vehicle at any time. Any person

found in the possession of a weapon will be reported to law enforcement.

All transit buses are wheelchair equipped and are in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities act.

HOLIDAYS & WEATHER

Hobbs Express will not operate and the office will be closed on all City observed holidays.

On occasion, Hobbs Express may implement detours on some or all of its routes. Severe weather, accidents, road construction or special events may cause a route deviation or temporary route change. Hobbs Express will not operate during adverse weather or road conditions. **During inclement weather, please listen to local radio stations for public announcements and further details.** Rider alerts and other details will be posted on Facebook. Route times are subject to change.

ROUTE DEVIATIONS

Buses Deviate from routes only in an extreme case or emergency.

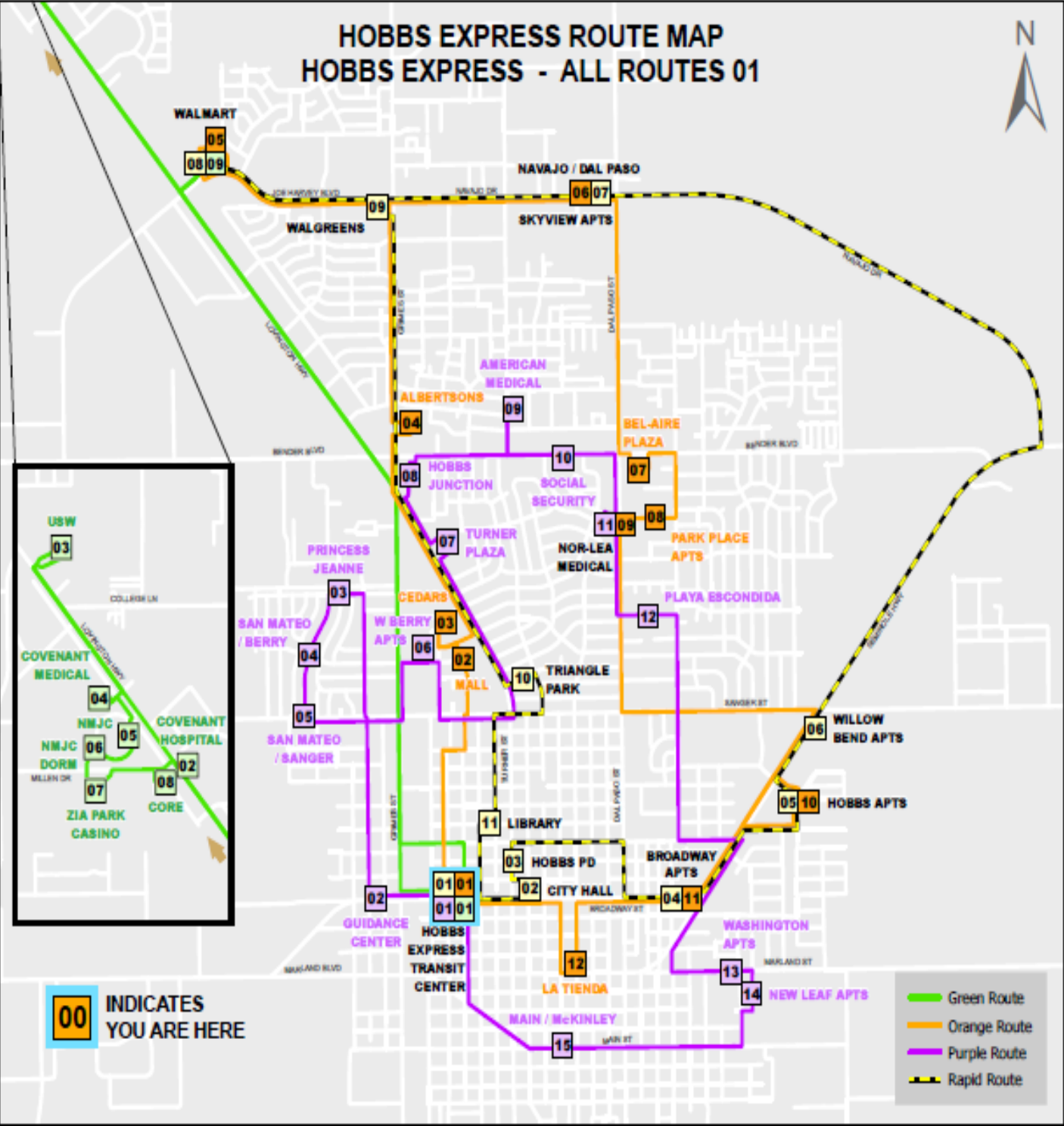
