The scope of work for Hobbs Veterans Memorial Park includes, but not limited to the following: Demolition of existing site elements such as concrete pads, electrical poles & equipment, irrigation equipment and post and cable fencing. Also included in project scope is clearing & grubbing, rough grading and dirt work. Contractor will install an asphalt parking lot with concrete curbing, concrete sidewalk and plaza paving, pilasters, free-standing walls and retaining walls with limestone caps and thin stone veneer, ornamental steel fencing and gates, brick pavers, flagpoles, granite monuments, artificial turf, electrical work and miscellaneous site furnishings. Additionally, this project includes landscaping comprised of trees, shrubs, turfgrass seeding and automatic irrigation system.


