The project will include two phases 1); design a rural cross section and prepare Construction Plans, Project Manual, and Bidding Documents for the widening of College Ln. from NM 18 to Grimes St.; and 2) analyze and design the realignment of College Ln. at NM 18 (Lovington Hwy) that will create a new intersection to include intersection geometry, drainage analysis, traffic volumes, environmental assessment, ITS, signalization & access management etc. in accordance with all New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) requirements.
